



**Title** Developing Guideline for the Officers of Dormitory Administration, Naresuan University

### Abstract

This research aims 1) to study the problems in administration the dormitory for personnel of Naresuan University into 4 aspects including the administration, services and welfares, environment, and participation problems, 2) to compare the problems of the officers who live in the dormitory of Naresuan University based on their genders and fields of work, And 3) to study guidelines in the developing dormitory of Naresuan University. The sample group, which derived from using the sample stratified proportional, is composed of 280 officers who live in the dormitory of Naresuan University. The instrument used for data collecting were questionnaires and interviews. The data were analyzed using percentage, mean, standard deviation, T-test, and one-way analysis of variance (One-way ANOVA) the examining the difference of the average pairwise used the method of Scheffe' content and data analysis.

The results show that:

1. The opinions of officers who live in the dormitory on the problems in 4 aspects were all at the middle level as follows: environment, services and welfares, management administration, and participation problems respectively
2. In comparing the officers' problems by dividing the gender and fields of work, it shows that the officers in different gender have the different environment problem with the statistical significance at 0.5 level. Where as the difference fields of work do not have any difference in statistical significance.
3. In guidelines for developing dormitory, the result shows that the rental rates should be adjusted to match with the room sizes and it should not separate the groups of renters by using field of work and the types of officers. In the services and welfares, there should be more Wi-Fi access areas. There should be enough lots for cars and motorbikes. Moreover, in participation problem, there should be more varieties of activities for officers to join.
